VOTER REGISTRATION REQUIREMENTS

Must be a U.S. Citizen.

Must be 18 years old. (may pre-register at 16 years of age)

Must be a Florida resident .

If you've been convicted of a Felony or declared mentally incompetent by the courts, you must have your right to vote restored pursuant to law. (F.S. 097.041)

CURRENT RESIDENTIAL ADDRESS

F.S. 101.045: A person is not permitted to vote in any election precinct or district other than the one in which the person has his or her legal residence and in which the person is registered.

An elector who moves from the precinct in which the elector is registered in, may vote in the precinct to which he or she has moved his or her legal residence , if the change of residence is within the same county or precinct to which the elector has moved his or her legal residence is within a county that uses an electronic database as a precinct register at the polling place, and the elector completes an affirmation.

REGISTER TO VOTE

In order to vote, citizens who will be 18 years or older by Election Day must register in the county they reside in. A voter remains registered as long as he/she is an active voter.
